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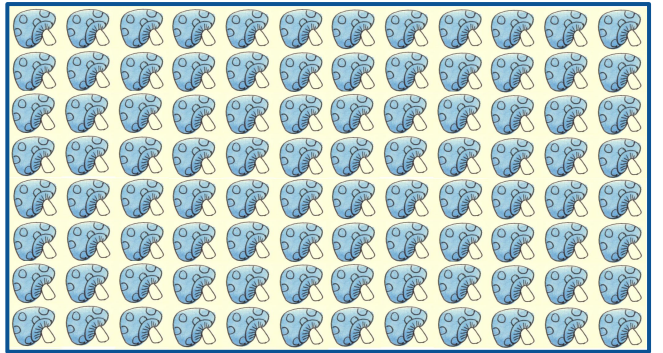
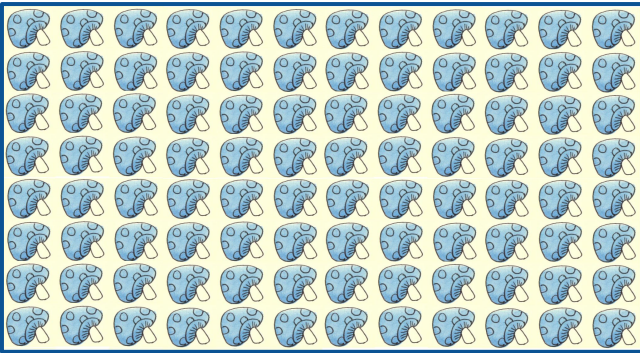
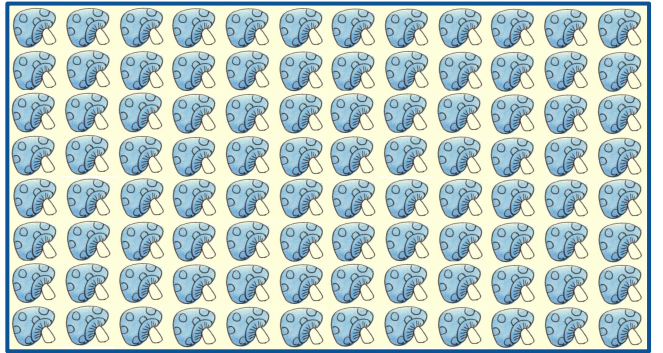
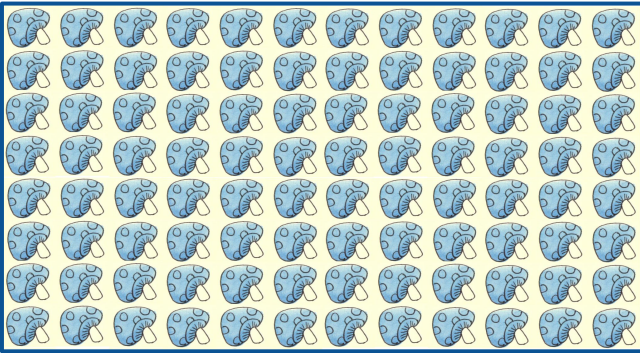
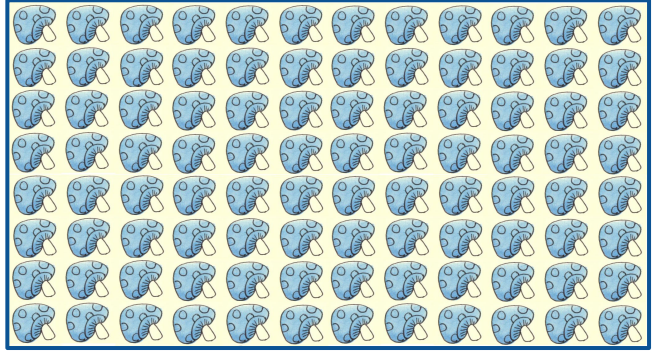
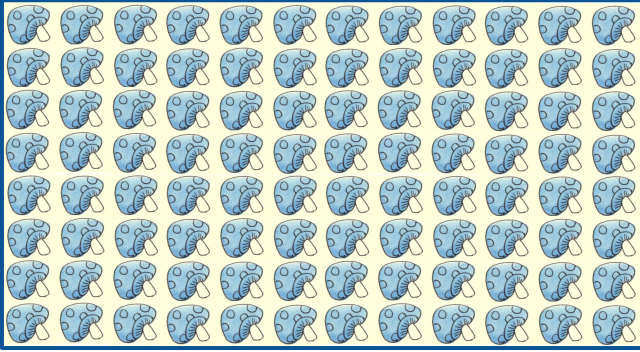
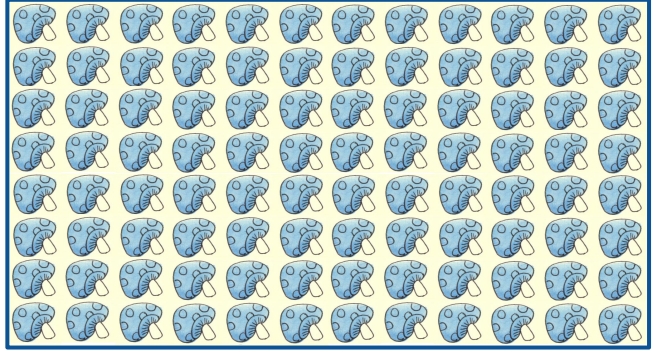
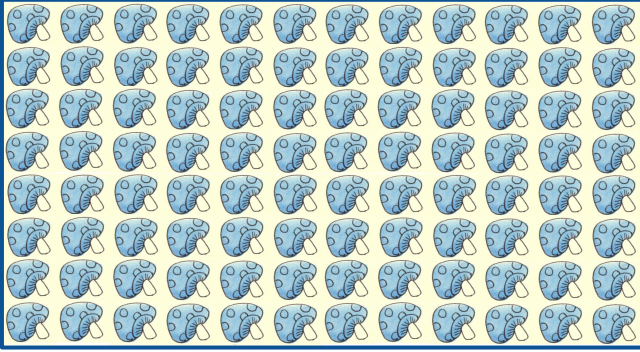
How to use this game:

First, print out all the cards as well as the list of idioms. Preferably you would either print this out on cardstock or laminate it immediately after printing. However, printing on regular paper and gluing to an index card works just as well. The mushroom cards are there to act as the back of your cards if you want it.

You need at least three people to play: two players and one reader.

The reader will place the cards in front of the players evenly. Then they will read a sentence from their list of English idioms/phrases.

The players will then race to touch the corresponding card; and the first one to do so gets to keep it as a point. This continues until no cards are left or until time is up. The player with the most cards wins.
